Community

The School District of Green Lake serves the educational needs of the city of Green Lake and the surrounding rural area. Located in central Wisconsin in a resort community, the district enjoys the benefits of small town living, an emphasis on recreation, and a concern for the environment. Currently, the district consists of 304 students, 4K – 12, under one roof. The student body is 96% white, 2% Black, 1% Asian, and 1% Hispanic. 3.6% of the student body is economically disadvantaged and 2% is of disability status.

School

The School District is the first IB World School (4k-12) in the State of Wisconsin with approved Diploma Programme (DP), Middle Years Programme (MYP), and Primary Years Programme (PYP). Green Lake High School is a comprehensive four-year public high school enrolling 102 students in grades 9 through 12. The high school is accredited by the State of Wisconsin.

Curriculum

The academic program is organized on a traditional two semester, eight period day schedule. Seven (7) credits per semester is the minimum course load a student may take. Students must earn 26 credits to receive a high school diploma.

International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme offering possibilities include the following: English HL, French/Spanish HL/SL, Economics SL, Geography SL, History HL, Psychology SL, Biology HL/SL, Chemistry HL/SL, Physics SL, Environmental Systems and Society SL, Math HL (Applications and AMP; Interpretations), Math SL (Applications and Interpretation), Music SL, Visual Arts SL, TOK (Theory of Knowledge), EE (Extended Essay), and CAS (Creativity, Action, Service). Students may choose to pursue the IB diploma or may choose to certificate (take the external assessment) in one or more of their IB classes. Students are not required to attempt to certificate in the courses they take.

The **Early College Credit and Start College Now** enables juniors and/or seniors to enroll in technical college or university courses and earn college credits at area institutions of higher education including but not limited to Ripon College (designated RC), Moraine Park Technical College (MPTC), or any college or university in the UW system.

Online High School Coursework is provided through the Wisconsin Virtual School to enrich the curriculum. Courses offered may be core, remedial, enrichment, or Advanced Placement (AP).

Rank

Rank-in-Class is based on grades in all courses. Courses are not weighted.

GPA Calculation

GPA is computed using the above quality points. Beginning with grade 9, all subjects, whether passed or failed, are included in the computation. A minimum of 26 credits is required for graduation (transfer students are prorated). Semester grades are recorded on the transcript and grade point average is computed in January and June. Courses in progress are also listed on the transcript.
